How does APSA define need?

APSA realizes that many practices do not have funds for their staff to attend the Educational Meeting. Each year APSA receives many applications for the scholarship fund. Among past recipients are those who worked for physicians having just completed their residency, another which was leaving a large group setting to start his own private practice, and another who was self funded. *All members are encouraged to apply*.
